**ARTrails Open Studios** – Every October, this juried program gives locals and visitors alike a behind-the-scenes glimpse into the visual art-making process. Visit with accomplished artists, view their work, learn how they create, and purchase original art for your own collection. ARTrails is consistently voted “Sonoma County’s Best Outdoor Art Event” by readers of the North Bay Bohemian.

## Collaborative Efforts

**Arts Sonoma Festival** – County-wide, multi-disciplinary festival of the arts, featuring core arts as well as fringe productions.

**Sonoma County Artist Awards** – This annual awards program recognizes artistic excellence and rewards three local artists with \$5,000 awards, supported by an endowment at Community Foundation Sonoma County.

**Arts Education** – In partnership with local, state, and federal collaborators, the Arts Council serves over 150 public and private schools, 320 teachers, and 4,320 individual students each year through Visual, Performing, Music, and Literary Arts education initiatives, including:

- **California Poets in the Schools** and **Poetry Out Loud**, which focus on increasing literacy and the value of poetry in its written and performative aspects.
- **Keeping Score**, a national program that provides K-12 teachers with intensive and ongoing training in music integration.
- **Arts Education Alliance**, a volunteer group comprised of artists, educators, and community members who work to bring quality arts education to Sonoma County.
- **The Advocacy Network**, a local affiliate of the California Alliance for Arts Education (CAAE) that meets monthly to identify strategic actions for supporting quality, equity, and access to arts education for all Sonoma County Students.
- **Adopt-a-School**, a three-phase program will target one Sonoma County elementary school to develop an integrated arts education program, including strategic planning and access to local arts events and to arts and artists in the classroom
